THIS WEEK IN BIBLE MEMORY:

SAY IT:

Say the verse together with your family. Let each family member add a prayer after saying the verse.

DO IT:

Buy a bag of popsicle sticks. Look up a recipe online (there are many healthy options) and make popsicles together. As they're freezing, have each family member write the memory verse on the extra sticks. Then build a popsicle house together, with the memory verse facing out so that it can always be seen.

TRY IT:

Plan a stargazing night with your family. Check out books from the library about constellations, find your nearest planetarium, or find out when the next meteor shower is going to occur. Be sure to go on a cloudless night to a place far enough away from city lights and pollution to see the night sky clearly! Ask your family what they think about when they see the stars.
